1. Complete the Application for Automobile Club Agent Registration
2. Once you submit your application and filing fee, we will complete the NOTICE OF APPOINTMENT on page 2. The Notice of Appointment must be completed *BEFORE* the form is submitted to the State of Kansas.
3. Page 1 of the form must be completed in its entirety
4. You must provide your email address on the form
5. Your information will go in the fields for Business Entity Name/Address etc
6. Make all necessary attachments, if any
7. You will need to submit an original form that includes your original signature. We cannot accept a fax, email or photocopy of a signature.
8. The form must be mailed in with the following filing fees:
 - a. ***Check or Money Order in the amount of \$15.00, made payable to Motor Club of America.***

CLUB AGENTS: Each person licensed in this state as a club agent shall, within thirty (30) days of occurrence, report to the Commissioner of Insurance:

- a. Each disciplinary action on the agent's license or licenses by the insurance regulatory agency of any other state or territory of the United States.
- b. Each disciplinary action on an occupational license held by the licensee, other than a club agent's license, by the appropriate regulatory authority of this or any other jurisdiction.
- c. Each judgment or injunction entered against the licensee on the basis of conduct involving fraud, deceit, misrepresentation, or violation of any insurance law.
- d. All details of any conviction of a misdemeanor or felony. Details should include the name of the arresting agency, the location and date of the arrest, the nature of the charge or charges, the court in which the case was tried, and the disposition rendered by the court. Minor traffic violations may be omitted.
- e. Each change in name; where the change of name shall be by court order, a copy of the court order shall be furnished to the Commissioner of Insurance.
- f. Each change in residence address.
- g. Each change in the name or address of the agency with which the agent is associated.

NOTICE OF APPOINTMENT

GUIDELINES FOR ANSWERING QUESTION 3

Traffic Violations

1. Minor traffic violations need not be disclosed.
2. For the purpose of the Application for Agent's License, the following are **not** considered minor traffic violations and must be disclosed.
 - a. Vehicular homicide.
 - b. Driving while intoxicated or driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
 - c. Driving while driver's license has been canceled, suspended or revoked.
 - d. Making false statements on an application for a driver's license.
 - e. Any crime punishable as a felony wherein a motor vehicle was used in the perpetration of such crime.
 - f. Leaving the scene of an accident without stopping to report it.
 - g. Failing to maintain continuous motor vehicle liability insurance.

"Yes" Responses

If you answered "Yes" to Question 3, please provide all details of each offense on a separate sheet of paper, including, but not limited to:

1. a written statement explaining the circumstances of each incident,
2. a copy of the charging document,
3. a copy of the official document, which demonstrates the resolution of the charges or any final judgment

NOTE: "Convicted" includes, but is not limited to, having been found guilty by verdict of a judge or jury, having entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere or no contest, or having been given probation, a suspended sentence, or a fine.
