SECTION C - REIMBURSEMENT FOR EMERGENCY TRAVEL OR LIVING EXPENSE

We will reimburse you for the following unexpected expenses incurred because your covered vehicle is disabled as a result of a collision with another vehicle or object.

- a. Rental of a replacement auto at the place of disablement while your covered vehicle is being repaired; or If the collision which caused the disablement occurs at least 50 miles or more from your residence:
- b. Commercial transportation at the place of disablement to continue to your destination or return home; or c. Local lodging and meals in the vicinity of the garage repairing your covered auto. This includes expenses
- for your spouse and children if they are traveling with you. Reimbursement for b.) and c.) are limited to expenses incurred during the first 72 hours following the collision. Total reimbursement will not exceed \$500.00 per occurrence. Accident must be investigated by State or local police and a copy of

the officers report must be submitted with your claim, as well as, billing from the repair facility showing the date your vehicle was released to you.
